Sir,

Senior Middle Classes.

According to the Director of Education the list of text books and teachers submitted by you for the above classes will not permit you to pursue the desired aim of Senior Middle Education - namely to prepare students for the Government Senior Middle Examination and the Cambridge School Certificate.

2. It is suggested, therefore, that yourself, principal Chan Jen Hao, Dr. Yen, the Senior Assistant Inspector of Chinese Schools and myself hold a meeting in Muar on the afternoon of February 6th to discuss this matter in detail.

3. It would appear that the Director of Education is not prepared to approve the syllabus as it stands at present, and therefore no sanction can yet be given to start a Senior Middle Class.
