Sir,

I have the honour to refer to your letter of 5th March, 1959, Ref: No. 40/5/58, in which you applied for an extension of 1 year to the Visit Pass of Mr. LIU PING CHIH @ Lau Peng Chee.

2. The application has been carefully considered, but since it does not receive the support of the Ministry of Education, it is regretted that the extension cannot be granted.

3. Mr. Liu should, therefore, make preparations to return to Hong Kong as soon as possible.

4. I return herewith the travel documents of Mr. Liu and his wife, with an extension up to 6th June 1959 which should enable him to complete his travel arrangements.

5. Before he leaves he should report to the Deputy Asst. Controller of Immigration, Johore Bahru (the Immigration office in Johore Bahru is situated in the main Government Building).

6. In the event of his being unable to leave by June 6th, he should likewise report in person with his travel document to the Deputy Asst. Controller of Immigration, Johore Bahru; but extension beyond 6th June will not be readily granted.

7. I enclose a letter to Mr. Liu informing him officially that his Visit Pass cannot be extended and that he must, therefore, leave by June 6th.
