I understand from a list supplied to the Asst. Organiser of Chinese Schools, Muar that it has been decided not to renew the contracts of 17 teachers in your school.

This is approximately one third of the total staff of the school which appears to us most alarming.

Please indicate, therefore, the grounds for the non-renewal of contract of each individual teacher concerned, giving full reason why each one has been considered unsatisfactory.

I have no doubt that you will readily appreciate that such a large change of staff at onetime is not healthy for any school, and should not be undertaken unless there are very compelling reasons.


