MINISTRY OF EDUCATION CIRCULAR No. 72

Constitution of Instrument of Government for Chinese
Secondary Schools.

Ministry of Education Circular No. 63 of 1960, Para 3, provides that Chinese Secondary Schools may elect to adopt either the constitution as set out in para 1 of Part 1 of Appendix G of the Model Instruments or in lieu of such constitution the alternative constitution attached to the circular just mentioned.

2. It is implicit that Chinese ~~Chinese~~ Secondary Schools which adopt the alternative constitution must amend Part 1 (3) of Appendix G of the Model Instruments to suit the alternative constitution.

3. In order to cope with the complexity of this constitution and to maintain uniformity, the Registrar-General of Schools has ruled that in the case of those which elect to adopt the alternative constitution, Part 1 (3) of appendix G of the Model Instruments should read as follows:

"(3) (1) Each governor shall hold office for a period of three years and shall be eligible for re-appointment:

Provided that when the board is first constituted one-third of the governors except the chairman, to be determined by lot, shall hold office for one year and one-third to be determined by lot, shall hold office for two years and one-third to be determined by lot, shall hold office for three years;

Provided further that when the board is first constituted if the total number of governors, excluding the Chairman is not divisible by three, then the quotient so derived shall be the number of governors who shall serve for one or two years and the quotient plus the remainder shall be the number of governors who shall serve for three years.

(ii) Notwithstanding the above provisions, all governors shall be eligible for re-appointment.

(iii) A governor may resign by signifying his intention in writing to the Chairman.

(iv) Vacancies for unexpired portion of a term of a governor shall be filled by appointment by the same authority as in the original appointment".
