

On receipt of a reply from the Chief Education Officer, Johore, last month inferming us that we have to try recruiting staff locally through advertisement before recruitment of teachers from abroad, we would like to inform you that our school have previously advertised for the recruitment of teachers locally without success on many occasions. As advised by the Education Department, Johore we have again advertised in the press as from 27.10.56 for two weeks. The response to the advertisement has been poor, the main reason being the general shortage of teachers in Chinese Schools in the Federation especially those in the Chinese Middle Schools. The acute shortage has been more so as there has been an increase of classes yearly in all schools. This sort of difficulty has long been a wellknown fact.

Moreover, reference may be made to the statistics regarding staff position from the Education Department.

We have forwarded the applications in response to our advertisement to the Education Authorities, Johore Bahru, who have certified, after perusal, to the effect that we have not with the difficulty of recruitment of staff locally. We forward herewith the following for favour of your reference and perusal so as to enable you consider our applications for the entry permite:-

- (a) 6 copies of our school advertisement for recruitment of staff locally;
- (b) 19 applications in response to our advertisement;
- (c) Letter from the Education Authorities, Johore Bahru, certifying the difficulty of recruitment of staff locally.
