The question of Mr. Liu's entry permit to which you refer in your letter of 6/4/1960 is now under active consideration and it is expected you will hear soon from the Controller of Immigration giving his decision.

As regards commercial classes, as soon as you are in a position to do so you should submit a separate request to open these classes giving detailed plans of how you propose to organise these classes, subjects to be taught whether for the Junior Middle or Senior Middle section, etc, and any other information you consider relevant. As soon as this is received it will be forwarded to the Ministry of Education, Kuala Lumpur for approval. No such classes should be started until formal approval is obtained.
